## **Receiving Holy Communion**

**May I give the following guidance regarding reception of Holy Communion:**

- **When you come forward to receive Holy Communion, from the host or chalice, before you receive Holy Communion you are asked to make a bow underlining your reverence for the Sacrament.**
- **Come close to the priest/eucharistic minister, don't stand too far away. This means that there is less likelihood of the host falling to the ground or the chalice slipping from your grasp.**
- **If you receive the host on your hand place your raised/flat hand upwards and the other hand below it (your right or left) pick up the host with the other hand below and place carefully on your tongue. Please avoid using either one hand only or swapping the host from one hand to the other.**
- **Please remember to say clearly the words AMEN. This is your assent to receiving Holy Communion. The priest or eucharistic minister says THE BODY/BLOOD OF CHRIST and you say IT TRULY IS (AMEN)**
- **Please do not walk away with the host. Receive the host before (in front of) the priest or eucharistic minister.**
- **Please do not turn away and consume the host as you return to your seat in church. Never take the host back to your seat**
- **If there are fragments of the host on your hand be sure to consume those also, do not let the fragments fall to the ground.**
- **If your hands are occupied by holding a stick or a baby or a book etc please receive the host on your tongue as there is less likelihood of it being dropped.**
- **Returning to your seat please make sure you take moments to say a prayer of thanksgiving. Please kneel down or be seated and still and reflective in this moment.**
- **Only the priest will give a blessing to the children who are not able to receive Holy Communion. These children are asked to indicate that they are coming forward for a blessing by placing their crossed hands on their breast. Please make sure they are close and directly in front of the priest.**
